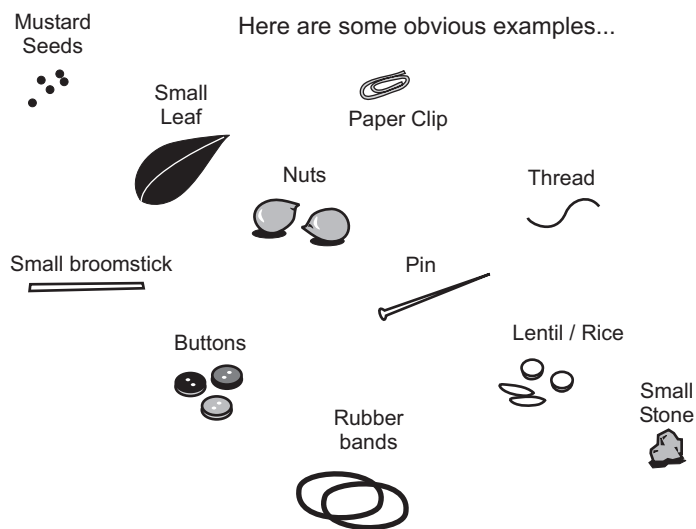


How many different things - one specimen of each can you pack in an ordinary matchbox? For this you will have to look for the littlest and tiniest things around you.
